Overview: New options are available on the SurgiNet IntraOp Document M-25, Surgical Procedures segment.

New Options Available on IntraOp M-25 Document – Surgical Procedures segment

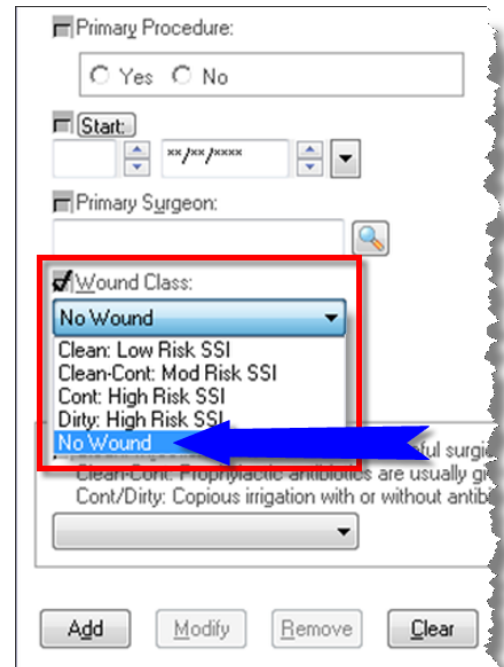
The SurgiNet Committee and Nursing CIS have approved the change from “N/A” wound class to “No Wound.” There is a new Clean Closure Used selectable and depending on which Wound Class is chosen, the Clean Closure check box will be *dithered or enabled*.

- When a user selects “Clean: Low Risk SSI” or “No Wound” the new **Clean Closure Used?** check box **will be dithered**.
- When a user selects “Clean-Cont: Mod Risk SSI” “Cont: High Risk SSI”, or “Dirty: High Risk SSI”, the **Clean Closure Used?** check box **will be enabled**.

All procedures which previously had an “N/A” Wound Class default will now have a “No Wound” Wound Class default. When the procedure is documented in the Surgical Procedures segment the defaults will continue to pull in correctly. The Infection Prevention Plan defaults were not altered and will still continue auto fill when certain Wound Classes are selected, depending on the Procedure.

“No Wound” now available on Wound Class drop-down:

“N/A” Wound Class has been deactivated; “No Wound” has taken its place as a selectable.



“Clean Closure Used?” enabled when Clean-Cont: Mod Risk SSI, Cont: High Risk SSI or Dirty: High Risk SSI selected for Wound Class:

When **Clean-Cont: Mod Risk SSI**, **Cont: High Risk SSI** or **Dirty: High Risk SSI** is selected, “**Clean Closure Used?**” is enabled.
