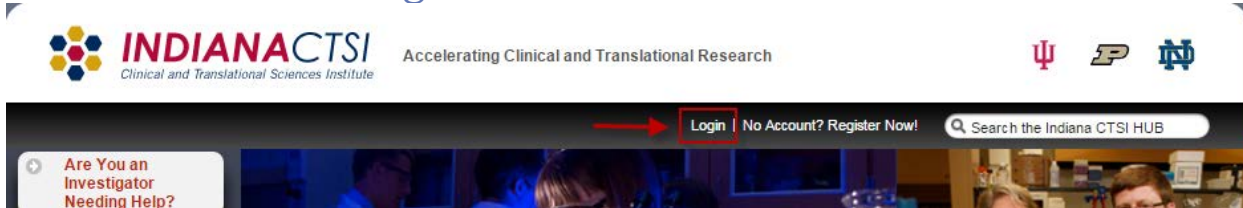


Accessing Indiana CTSI

Important

All IU employees must allow five (5) business days prior to the 2015 application deadline or Monday October 19, 2015 in order to obtain their approval and meet the Monday October 26, 2015 @ 5:00pm deadline. This additional time allows sufficient time for the Office of Research Administration to review and sign off on applications before submission to the CTSI web site.

IU Health Values Fund Grants

The IU Health board of directors has announced four separate grant programs.

Full application for each program is due by 5pm, 26 October 2015.

The new IU Health Values Fund Grand Challenge for Population Health (VFGC) with a maximum award of \$250,000/yr. or \$500,000 for two (2) years requires that a Letter of Intent to be submitted to ictsi@iu.edu or 317.278.4842 by Friday, September 18, 2015@5:00pm. The Indiana University Values Fund for Grand Challenge, the Indiana University Health Values Fund for Education (VFE), the Indiana University Health for Research (VFR) and the Indiana University Health Values Fund for The Integration of Religious and Spiritual Dimensions in Health Care (aka "Spirituality") (VFS) full grant application must be submitted to the CTSI HUB grants portal at www.indianactsi.org/grants by the Monday, October 26, 2015 @5:00pm deadline.

Ivy, M.Div., Ph.D. (sivy@iuhealth.org), Senior Vice President for Values Ethics, Social Responsibility & Pastoral Services in care of his Administrative Assistant, Sarah A. Rush (Srush7@iuhealth.org, Tel:317.962.3591) . The full application should also be submitted to the www.indianactsi.org website.

Any questions regarding the submission of the LOI or full application should be addressed to Dr. Ivy's attention in care of his Administrative Assistant, Sarah A. Rush. The full application has a due date of Monday, October 26, 2015@5:00pm.

The Indiana University Values Fund for Research/Medical Research (VFR) and the Values Fund for Education (VFE) have a maximum award of \$50,000/yr./\$100,000 for two years. Proposal submission must be through the CTSI HUB grants system/website portal at www.indianactsi.org/grants

Pre-Application meetings or open informational sessions will be held in which applicants may ask and learn more about the Values Fund application process.
