
When ordering breast milk, mixed formulas, and/or donor milk orders in Cerner, please follow the below order entry protocol:

Breast Milk Orders

- Do NOT use Cancel/Reorder
- For changes to volume or order comments, use Modify
- For Calorie and/or Recipe changes, Cancel/DC order and Place New Order

Donor Milk or Mixed Formula Orders

- Modify is not an available function
- For changes to volume or order comments, use
 Cancel/Reorder. Do not make changes to Additives!
- For Calorie and/or Additive changes, Cancel/DC order and Place New Order



Highlights

Remember:

- All Breast Milk order changes (Recipe, Volume) should be placed by 13:00
- Changes to Continuous feeding orders should take place at 16:00.
- Changes to bolus feeding orders should take place at 17:00

Modify: USE for Breast Milk Orders

Cancel/Reorder: DO NOT USE for Breast Milk Orders, may USE for Donor Milk/Formula volume or order comment changes only

Cancel/DC: USE for Breast Milk,
Donor Milk, and Formula Orders
when changing Calories, Recipes, or
Additives
