
Overview: Joint Commission requires that post-operative and post-procedure notes be completed immediately and before the patient is transferred to the next level of care for surgeries or procedures with moderate sedation, deep sedation or anesthesia. Follow instructions below to access PowerNote templates that have been created to facilitate complete documentation

| Step | Action |
|------|---|
| 1 | Open patient's chart in Cerner |
| 2 | Click the PowerNote Band  |
| 3 | Click +Add  |
| 4 | Click the Catalog tab |
| 5 | Validate the Catalog is IUH Inpatient , <i>If it is not, use dropdown to select IUH Inpatient.</i>  |
| 6 | To find SN Immediate Postop Note: Click the (+) sign beside <i>Surgical Immediate Post-Op</i> <i>OR</i> To find Procedure Notes: Click the (+) sign beside <i>Procedures</i>  |
| 7 | Select SN Immediate Postop Note or the specific Procedure Note <i>The note can be used for moderate sedation, deep sedation, or anesthesia cases regardless of location.</i> <div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-around;"> <div style="width: 45%;"> <p>SN Immediate Post Op Note</p>  </div> <div style="width: 45%;"> <p>Procedure Notes - List of Selections</p>  </div> </div> |
